



Aerotropolis Transfer Main

We will soon be constructing a 10.5 km transfer main in the roads of Austral and Kemps Creek.

What we're doing

Sydney Water is working with the NSW government to provide water to the Aerotropolis.

Stage 1 of the Aerotropolis lays the groundwork for a significant contribution of up to 200,000 new jobs and up to 60,000 new homes in Western Sydney.

Through these developments, the Aerotropolis will become a centre of employment for industries including education and research, technology, agribusiness and health.

About 10.5km of pipeline will be laid in the road corridor over the next few months.

Construction

There will be noisy construction activities associated with this work including saw-cutting and digging in the road and road verge. You will also notice an increase in noise and vehicle movements.

Detours and traffic control will be in place to guide road users and protect the local community and our workers.

Drinking water and wastewater services will not be affected by our work.

Timing

Construction will start in early February 2020 and is expected to finish by July 2020.

This project will be completed in five stages. We will provide local updates as the construction crews move along the alignment.

Our construction work hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays. No work will occur on Sundays or public holidays.
